Why a ski course?

Who? Any current level of skier (see Levels tab) or non-skier, whether you are a complete Beginner ('Never-Ever'*); Novice or Improver ('Once or Twicer'*); lower, middle or upper Intermediate (the 'Stem-Busters'*); Advanced or Expert ('Beyond Expectation'*). Minimum age 13 years, unless in one Family & Friends group booking of similar ability level, then it's a minimum age of 10 years. See Penguin Club for 4-9 years.

What? 5 sessions over 5 consecutive weeks, approximately 2 hours per session and limited to a maximum of 8 people per course to ensure personalised attention. Every course* is geared towards a specific level and our nationally qualified instructors will guide you through. The courses are structured towards improvement and progression and can be adapted to focus partly on individual needs, partly on specific techniques. The same instructor will usually take most of the 5 sessions. Beginner courses include advice on equipment, clothing and safety and what to expect from a ski holiday so you can make the best of your time in the mountains.

When? Winter (October to March on Thursday evening or Sunday afternoon) or summer (April to September any day subject to demand)or to put it another way, any time of year! Start dates are set once a minimum of 3 people have booked, and the courses cannot be joined part-way through.

Where? At the EXETER AND DISTRICT SKI CLUB, of course!

How much? (the important bit!) For this season, the cost for each 5-session course has been reduced to £60 (Juniors £48) so day members get one free! Or, to put it another way, 20% discount! Please pay by cash or cheque with cheque guarantee card details, on application at least one week before the course start date. Mike will give you the details.

What if? I can't make it for one of the sessions? Sorry, the course fees are not refundable; however, our Instructor will do his best to bring you up to date at your next session (please note that if more than one session is missed, you may not be able to re-join)

Then what happens? On completion, you will receive a signed certificate and course packand then you can think about booking your next course!
